3.1) What aspect(s) of this instructor or course did you like the most and why?

- Great!!! communicated a lot with skype helped a lot
- I like how the instructor is timely in responding to emails
- I really liked how involved he was with the class. He seemed to really care about us students by making sure we understood the material thoroughly. He tried to answer all of our questions. He provided lecture slide handouts and even did extra lecturing videos when the class was especially struggling with something. This all made me feel very comfortable in learning the material.
- I think the teacher did a great job of getting back to the students quickly. Because whenever I sent an email the teacher had feedback within two days.
- Professor Statenburg got back to any questions I had in a timely manner. If we did not understand a class assignment he went out of his way to make video clips or explain in a different way. He was an excellent Instructor.
- The thing I enjoyed most about the class was that it allowed me to view other perspectives I am not used to looking at and made me think outside the box.

3.2) What aspect(s) of this instructor or class did you like the least and why? Feel free to suggest ways the class may be improved.

- I found it a little difficult to figure out the syllabus and when assignments were due. It might help if the due date was listed with the homework assignment.
- I really like how my questions were answered thoroughly when I asked them but I think sometimes the feedback came too late in order to accurately complete some assignments. I like how the professor was willing to use Skype or phone calls to communicate too.
- I think this particular class would have been easier if taken in the class room!
- The schedule of assignments and their due dates was made mostly clear, but I still found myself sometimes scrambling to find out what exactly was due and when. I think spelling everything day by day on the course calendar would be extremely helpful. I actually did this myself on my own personal calendar, but it took a lot of time and it still wasn't perfect. Also, due dates listed with each assignment (such as in the assignment drop box) would be very helpful as well.
